

CMYK, RGB & Pantone®

Print based colors consist of 4-Color Process, CMYK, whereas web based colors consist of RGB/HEX color. It is very important to understand the difference and use the correct color setting for different purposes.

Pantone® Matching System is used in print design, and it is a largely standardized color reproduction system. The best way to decide on a color is to choose a Pantone® color using an appropriate version of Pantone® Book. Next step is to determine the color should be converted to CMYK (based on a total number of colors being used for printing for cost effectiveness) or to RGB/HEX color. A HEX color is expressed as a six-digit combination of numbers and letters defined by RGB. In other words, a HEX color code is shorthand for its RGB values with a little conversation gymnastics in between.



CMYK

- · Stands for Cyan, Magenta, Yellow, and Black
- Created for print design
- Uses 4 colors to produce different hues (4-Color Process)



RGB

- · Stands for Red, Green and Blue
- Uses 3 colors or channels to reproduce colors on screen
- An RGB color can be also represented in a HEX color code



Pantone® Matching System (PMS)

- Used in print design
- Largely standardized color reproduction system
- · Basically means a paint bucket



Color Palette Print Use

Color is a powerful visual tool and provides a strong means of visual recognition. There are, essentially, two Oakridge colors — The Oakridge School Blue (PMS 295) and The Oakridge School Green (PMS 3435).

To ensure color consistency, attach the appropriate Oakridge color samples to all artwork for any printing materials. Matching these colors in 4-Color Process may not be exact but should be visually matched as closely as possible.




Color Palette Web Use

Color is a powerful visual tool and provides a strong means of visual recognition. There are, essentially, two Oakridge colors — The Oakridge School Blue (PMS 295) and The Oakridge School Green (PMS 3435).

To ensure color consistency, attach the appropriate Oakridge color samples to all artwork for any web materials including the website and the social media. Matching these colors in RGB may not be exact but should be visually matched as closely as possible. The 2 RGB blues were determined by Finalsite.


The Oakridge School Style Guide Quick Reference
