In particular, the through-year (Mini- SOL) assessment will assess only grades 3-8; MAP is currently used to assess students in grades 2-12. MAP is a growth assessment that allows the division to track students' achievement and growth as they matriculate over time. The Mini-SOL cannot assess growth next year; only whether a student has mastered the content from the prior school year. MAP allows the division to see precisely what each student knows and is ready to learn - whether performing below, on, or above-grade level (as opposed to solely whether a student has mastered the prior year's content). Analysis of MAP data for use in instructional planning can help teachers more efficiently group students and provide appropriate instruction relative to student needs.	MR			x
