The Tri-Valley Local School District Wellness Committee held their annual meeting on March 15, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. in the middle school library. Members included various administrators, teacher, and parents of school age children attending the District.

The wellness committee membership goal is to have members that represent all school levels (elementary and secondary schools) and include (to the extent possible), but not be limited to: parents and caregivers, students, representatives of the school nutrition program, physical education teachers, health education teachers, school health professionals, school administrators, school board members, health professionals, and the general public.

The March 15, 2019 committee meeting agenda and notes are listed below.

- Review of the current school wellness policy that was adopted by the BOE on August 10, 2017.
  - All members received and reviewed a copy of the current wellness policy.

  - Upon review of the current policy, several areas were noted that are only partially implemented. Discussions were held on full implementation timelines and responsibilities.
  
- Assignment of roles, responsibilities, actions, and timelines for full implementation of the current wellness policy at each school.
  - Building principals were assigned to further review and assure full implementation of the policy in the following areas by the 2019-2020 school year
    - Nutrition Education
    - Essential Healthy Eating Topics in Health Education
    - Physical Activity
    - Physical Education
    - Essential Physical Activity Topics in Health Education
  
  - The Director of Operations was assigned to review and assure full implementation of the policy in the following areas by the 2019-2020 school year
    - Recordkeeping
    - Annual Notification of Policy
    - Triennial Progress Assessments
    - School Meals
    - Staff Qualifications and Professional Development
    - Food and Beverage Marketing in Schools
