

Please see below a top tips / guidance to access and use the remote learning offer:


1. Please log onto our Academy website: https://www.poundhillinfantacademy.org.uk/
Then hover your mouse cursor over the tab 'Teaching and Learning'. You will see the following tab: 'Remote learning'




2. When you access this page, you will need to click on your child's year group



3. You will then see the Weekly Learning together And the Remote Learning Grid. (Click on the timetable to view the whole week)




4. Click on the curriculum home learning resources links in the grid to access, powerpoints, video and worksheets for Phonics, English and Maths. You will then be asked for a passkey, please email office@phiacademy.org.uk



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
5. Click on the subject Phonics, English or Maths and then choose the relevant Term and Week number.

- You can access the ppt resources by clicking on the 'drop down arrows', click on the arrow once nd it will enable you to download the presentation and access features such as live links or voiceovers.



- Some files are saved as a PDF. You can access this by clicking twice onto it to view the presentation. A PDF document is similar to a book view of the lesson. It does not contain any interactive features. Other presentations on our website that have the 'drop down' arrow a shown above, will provide you with features such as live video links, or voice overs from your child's class teacher. The drop down arrows are the only downloads that contain these. Please right click on the arrow and choose 'open in new tab', this will download the powerpoint and allow you to open.
