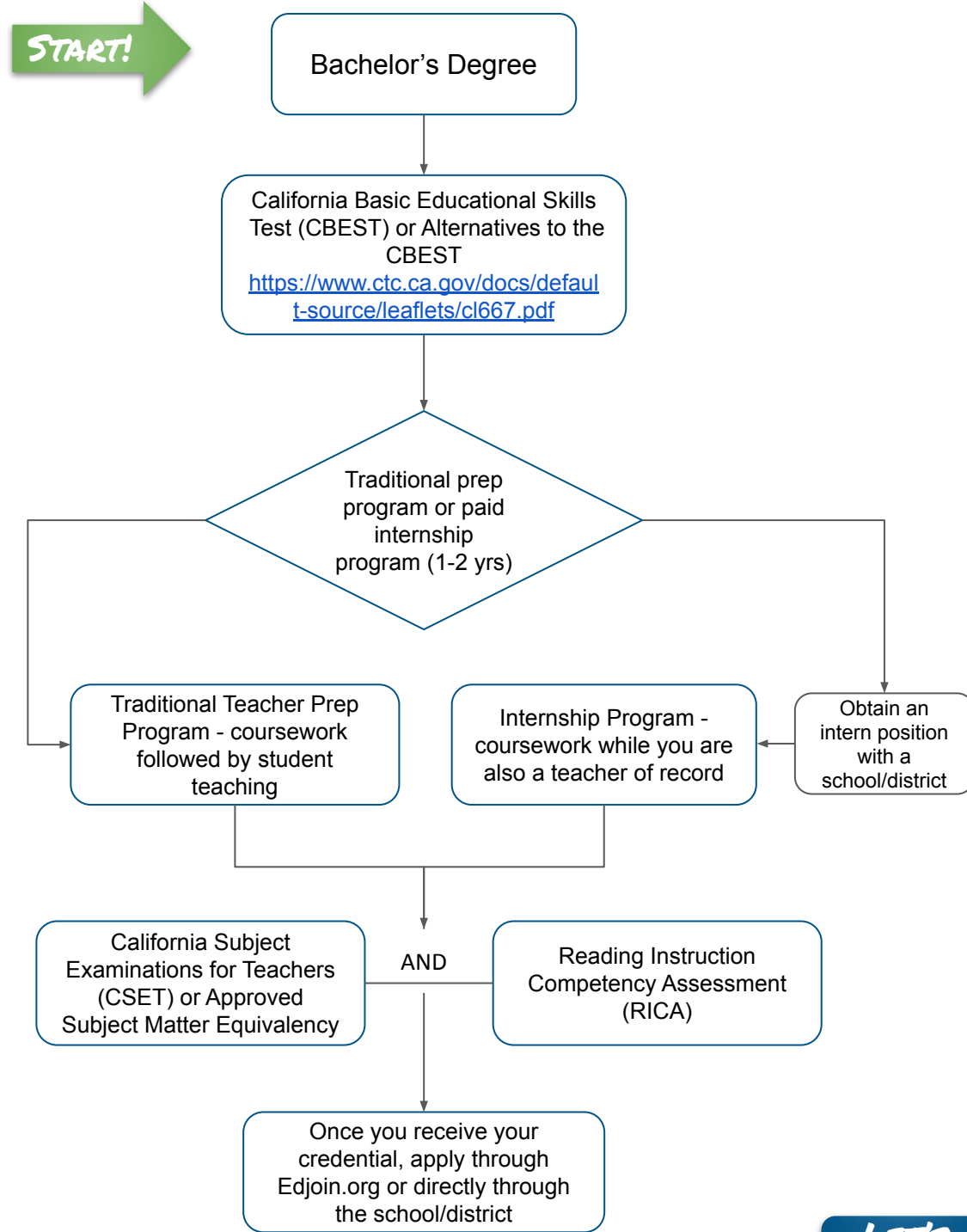




There are many pathways to becoming an educator.

Multiple Subject Credential - CA

Self-contained classroom - typically elementary but can be preschool-12, or in classes primarily for adults

Traditional - potential access to federal financial aid
