





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ATTENDANCE IS THE  KEY

**2018-2019 School Attendance End of Year Report**  
**Departmental Goal Achievement and Attendance Initiatives**

During the 2018-2019 SY, the Superintendent's Attendance Initiative introduced by Superintendent Russell during the 2016-2017 SY was continued and focused on decreasing chronic absenteeism. Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing 10 percent or more of school days including all absences, excused or unexcused and suspensions. Attendance awareness messaging to parents, students, school staff, and community stakeholders went out at the beginning of the SY in August. The district focused on attendance in September for Attendance Awareness Month with the kick off of the Everybody Every Day Campaign. The campaign included a student contest, the *Everybody Every Day Poem, Poster, Video Rap/Song Contest* which encourages students to display their artistic creativity while highlighting why school attendance is important to education and school achievement. There were 38 winners in the respective categories that were awarded. The Shirley H. Lee Community Support for School Attendance Award Recipient was awarded to Ms. Ingrid Cruz, School Counselor, Deltona Lakes Elementary School, for her commitment to promoting regular school attendance. Other attendance initiatives included:

- 173 students were awarded a certificate at their respective schools based on their perfect attendance for the 2017-2018 SY
- Excellence in Attendance Award which recognizes the schools with the highest attendance rate at the elementary, middle, high school, and alternative levels at the end of each semester. Winners for first semester of the 2018-2019 SY were: Coronado Beach Elementary at 96.71%; Campbell Middle at 97.06%; Deltona High at 97.10%; and PACE Center for Girls at 98.07%. The second semester winners were: Cypress Creek Elementary at 95.80%; Campbell Middle at 96.40%; Deltona High at 96.55%; and PACE Center for Girls at 97.25%.
- The final district attendance initiative was the Superintendent's Attendance Challenge Award. This award was given to the top schools at each level achieving the highest reduction in chronic absenteeism (CA) during the third nine-weeks of the 2018-2019 SY. The winners were:
  - ❖ Elementary: 1st place, Sunrise Elementary began with 14.2% and ended with 11.2% CA rate; 2nd place, Port Orange Elementary began with 14.9% and ended with 12.1% CA rate; 3rd place Osceola Elementary, began with 17.2% and ended with 14.5% CA rate;
  - ❖ Middle: 1st place, David C. Hinson Middle began with 14.9% and ended with 12.3% CA rate; 2nd place, Galaxy Middle began with 15.1% and ended with 13.5% CA rate; 3rd place, River Springs Middle began with 13.1% and ended with 11.9% CA rate;
  - ❖ High: 1st place, Deltona High began with 9.5% and ended with 7.7% CA rate; 2nd place, New Smyrna High began with 10.9% and ended with 9.5% CA rate; 3rd place, Atlantic High began with 13.8% and ended with 12.8% CA rate;
  - ❖ Duel Challenges: Horizon Elementary vs. Spruce Creek Elementary; Winner, Spruce Creek Elementary began at 15.6% and ended with 13.7% CA rate; Palm Terrace Elementary vs. Westside Elementary; Winner, Palm Terrace Elementary began at 21.8% and ended with 20.3% CA rate;
  - ❖ In addition to the winners, 48 schools met the chronic absenteeism goal of reducing their CA rate by 10%
- Nudge letters initiative continued, and every school had the capability to distribute these letters to parents which compares student's chronic absenteeism with the district, school and grade level of the student. Elementary continued to receive automated; Elementary and Secondary were capable of printing letters on demand.
- eCare Initiative with VCS and Advent Health began in January 2019. Monthly CA data for the identified 36 schools was provided. Participating schools were Blue Lake Elementary, Champion Elementary, Deland Middle, Holly Hill School, Palm Terrace Elementary, Pine Ridge High, Spirit Elementary, Taylor Middle-High, Turie T. Small Elementary, Westside Elementary, Discovery Elementary, Horizon Elementary, Manatee Cove Elementary, Osceola Elementary, South Daytona Elementary, Starke Elementary, Creekside Middle, Galaxy Middle, Heritage Middle, Ormond Beach Middle, Deltona Lakes Elementary, Edgewater Public School, Enterprise Elementary, Friendship Elementary, Indian River Elementary, Longstreet Elementary, McInnis Elementary, Orange City Elementary, Osteen Elementary, Pierson Elementary, Pride Elementary, Read-Pattillo Elementary, Spruce Creek Elementary, Volusia Pines Elementary, and Deltona Middle

- 1st Senior Winner for Perfect Attendance was awarded from Deland High
- Walking School Bus Initiative was implemented on 5/22/19 at Indian River Elementary
- Collaboration with Volusia County Sheriff's Office continued this SY. The School Resource Officers and other police officers made regular home visits to students who were habitually truant on teacher duty days, holidays, etc.
- Collaboration with Stewart Marchman Act-CINS/FINS Program, State Attorney's Office and Volusia County Teen Court Program to follow-up on truancy referrals

The 2018-2019 Attendance Goals for School Social Work Services were:

1. To work collaboratively with Florida Hospital to reduce the chronic absenteeism rate at the identified 36 schools. Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing at least 10% of school days in a year for any reason, excused or unexcused. Social Workers were able to disaggregate chronic absenteeism attendance data by using the chronic absences report and the KEEP report and share this information with the identified schools monthly. Social Workers provided attendance training at all 36 schools focused on reducing chronic absenteeism. Social Workers promoted attendance and engagement initiatives, and provided support to schools, students, and their families to improve attendance. Attendance Court Liaison provided Florida Hospital the chronic absenteeism rate for all 36 pilot schools each month which reflect absenteeism of the student population.

2. To decrease the percentage of students who are habitually truant with emphasis on the homeless population. Social Workers worked towards this goal by monitoring school attendance, disaggregating attendance data, promoting attendance and engagement initiatives, and providing support to schools, students, and their families to improve attendance.

School Social Workers assisted school-based staff in identifying all truant students (students with 15 or more unexcused absences within a 90 calendar period) at each of their assigned schools by providing monthly habitual truancy reports and inquiring about interventions for those students on the list. Documented interventions were provided to the Coordinator of School Social Services monthly. The overall rate of students who were habitual truants for the 2018-2019 SY was 3.5% which represents 2212 students of the total population of truant students. The overall rate of homeless students who were habitually truant was 20.5% which represents 454 students of the total population of truant students. The overall rate of ESE students who were habitually truant was 35% which represents 774 students of the total population of truant students. The overall rate of students who were chronically absent was 14.2% (8865 students). The district rate for homeless students who were chronically absent was 13.2% (1168 students). The district rate for ESE students who were chronically absent was 30.7% (2720 students).

For the 2018-2019 SY, 903 attendance referrals were received. School Social Workers submitted 1 Teen Court referral, 96 CINS/FINS referrals, 99 ASAP referrals, and 20 adult court referrals submitted to the State Attorney's Office for violation of the compulsory school attendance law.

The School Social Workers for Attendance were supportive in assisting the district in resolving DNE withdrawal codes again this school year in order to ensure that the district's count was accurate for the submission to FLDOE for annual withdrawal reporting (i.e. Survey 2-5). On 8/14/18, there were 2121 students coded as DNE. All DNE codes were resolved by 2/11/19.

School Social Workers provided follow-up services to 227 terminated home education students and families. The Team assisted the Home Instruction/Off Campus Instruction programs by providing follow-up services for 10 students who were not accessing the services. Two School Social Workers assigned to the alternative education schools provided transition services for those students who were placed at Highbanks Learning Center or Riverview Learning Center by the District Student Placement Committee or their respective (ESE) IEP teams.

In October 2015, the Obama Administration launched *Every Student, Every Day: A National Initiative to Address and Eliminate Chronic Absenteeism* with a goal to decrease it by at least 10 percent each school year. Research shows that missing at least 10 percent of school days in a year for any reason is a primary cause of low academic achievement and a powerful predictor that students will eventually drop out of school.

\*Note: Due to the constraints of the data system, the chronic absenteeism rate is only inclusive of excused and/or unexcused absences and does not include out of school suspensions for the 2014-2015 school year.
