At Richard Milburn Academy, we believe that all students can achieve excellence in a positive, challenging educational environment that stimulates their interests, channels energy, and develops abilities.

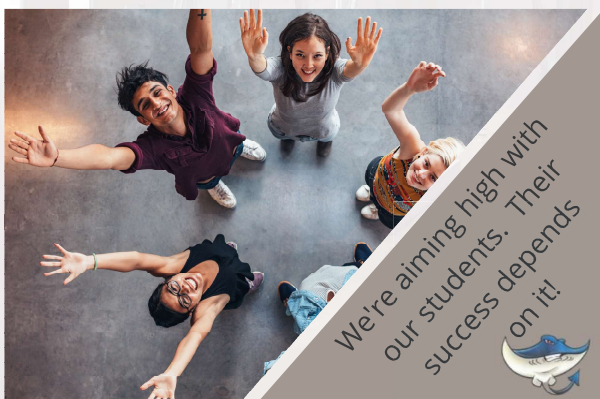
THE RMA COMMITMENT

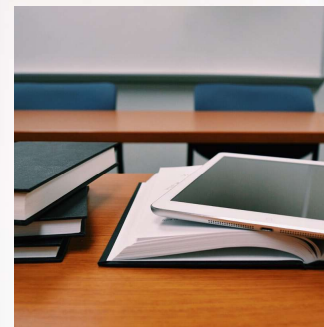

LEARNING AT RMA

RMA offers a complete high school curriculum that includes the following components:

- Core curriculum offerings of English, social studies, math, and science
- Elective course selections such as humanities, foreign language, and a variety of other subjects
- Academic core curriculum skill improvement, including reading, writing, spelling, and mathematics
- A program focus on high school completion and student preparation for success after graduation.



OUR STUDENTS

RMA is designed to assist high school students who have been challenged at succeeding in a traditional high school environment. We are skilled in providing educational opportunities to students who:

- Are high school dropouts, or those at risk of dropping out.
- Have poor or erratic attendance.
- Are behind in earning credits or in need of credit recovery.
- Have not met or exceeded the required academic standards.
- Experience long-term or frequent suspensions.
- Were formerly expelled but are eligible for enrollment or are transitioning from juvenile detention.

THE RMA MISSION

RMA High School motivates and challenges at-risk adolescents to achieve academic excellence, employment success, and social responsibility by providing non-traditional experiential learning opportunities in which students develop self-confidence, self-worth, self-discipline, and self-acceptance.

RESPONSIVENESS TO STUDENTS' NEEDS

We know how complex – even chaotic – life can be for students. Some students may be living away from home, caring for a child, or working. For us at RMA, it matters not from where a student comes: it is where he or she is going! It is our goal to help each student step-by-step along the way towards building a bright future.

HOW WE DO IT

Through classes smaller than those typically found in traditional high schools, along with flexible hours and a supportive learning environment, we at RMA foster an atmosphere in which students help other students, and our teachers provide one-on-one support.

Our student-centered approach includes instruction that matches students' individual learning styles and personal goals. At RMA, students have the opportunity to develop work skills and gain a real-world view of choices beyond school.
