September 13, 2022	Public Hearing and Adoption of <i>Final District Budget & Final FY22 Budget Amendment</i>
September 15, 2022	Superintendent certifies adopted millage to Property Appraiser and Tax Collector.
September 16, 2022	District Summary Budget Online and Supporting Documents to DOE
September 23, 2022	Certify Final Millage Rate – Notify Property Appraiser, Tax Collector and Department of Revenue
After Value Adj. Board 3 days after receipt	Property Appraiser notifies taxing authority of final adjusted tax roll (DR-422) School District certifies DR-422 to Property Appraiser. After VAB Hearing the Appraiser extends the tax roll
By October 2022	School District certifies compliance with 200.65 and 200.68 FL. Statutes to the Dept. of Revenue
