COMMENTS

Along with their regular classroom work, and going on enjoyable field trips, the students have been doing the practice tests for the CAASPP. We have increased the number of the practice tests this year to better equip the students with the format and languaging of the state test. It also allows the teachers to go over concepts with the students where there may be challenges. Students have also been doing mid-year assessments, and the teachers are now working on second trimester report cards.

In the office, we have been busy with parent tours, both during the day and in the evenings. Each application is looked over carefully, and then the lottery AA adds each one to the spreadsheet for Central Administration. Montessori experience forms are verified, as well. It always makes me proud to see how many families are interested in our program!

Our 2nd annual National Geographic Geography Bee occurred last month, and our campus winner once again qualified for the state finals! One hundred 4th through 8th grade students will compete at Fresno State. Due to the interest in this topic, a Geography Club has been started, with 17 attendees so far.

We are thrilled to have the Internet and phone system installed into the portable which houses our library and Club Montessori. The Intel grant for PC Pals program funded the project. Thank you to Sarah Templeton for coordinating and overseeing the work.

Our campus will be showing the *Screenagers* video next month, with one evening showing to parents, then daytime showings to the upper elementary and middle school students. Other CMP campuses have purchased the rights to have showings, and it was communicated to us what very worthwhile information is imparted.
