

## **DRAFT COMMUNITY USE OF CMP DISTRICT-LEASED FACILITIES**

Per the Civil Center Act (Ed Code 38131), charter school campuses operating in District facilities must make those facilities accessible to the citizens of the county, such as: parent/teacher groups, scout troops, clubs, and associations for recreational or educational activities.

Charges for use of school facilities that are after school hours are set by the District, and individuals or groups must contact the appropriate District office for application forms and procedures.

Use of the facilities that are after school operation hours by CMP staff, parent volunteers, or other school-approved individuals will follow the same procedures with the District office to receive approval for the use of the facility, the fees charged, and the proper procedures.

Any damages of school property will be addressed by the CMP superintendent or designee, the campus principal, as well as the district designee if the damage is to the facility itself.

### **Priority of Uses**

Because the campus has a limited number of rooms, demand for use that exceeds the number of rooms available must be based on a priority ranking:

- Activities for or authorized by the CMP campus
- The California Superintendent of Public Instruction, the State Board of Education, or federal educational agencies
- Elementary, secondary, unified, and community college districts in the school's county
- Private nonprofit organizations serving handicapped children in the school's county
- Other school-related private nonprofit organizations
- Public universities in the school's county
- Other local governmental agencies
- Other private, nonprofit organizations
- Other private groups or individuals

### **Prohibited Uses**

The following public uses are prohibited:

- The operation of any powered machinery unless as approved by the CMP superintendent or designee for educational purposes during school hours
- The use of open flame except as part of an established school event with adult supervision
- Any use by CMP staff for profit or other personal benefit
- The sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages
- Prohibiting the use for community and governmental agencies as listed above
- Charge of an admission fee except when the fee is charged by a nonprofit organization or governmental agency
- Any use which interferes with or is likely to interfere with the instruction of students or other operations of the school
- Smoking inside any of the buildings
- Any use that is prohibited by City or County ordinances
- Any activity that is prohibited by federal or state law
