## College Credit Options

- **CT<sup>2</sup> Statewide Articulation Agreements = 11 college credits**
  - AND {
    - Earn a “C” or better in the Introduction to Hospitality and Tourism (330000), fundamentals of Food Production (330100), Restaurant Management (330120)
    - Pass the Webxams for each course earning 2, 4 & 3 college credits respectively (*Each course is worth college credits. They are be earned independently of each other*)
    - Earn the ServSafe certification –(2 additional college credits)
    - Submit proper paper work
    - Credits accepted at all state schools in Ohio **IF** a culinary degree is offered
  
- **Tech Prep @ Tri-C = 3-10 college credits**
  - Earn a 2.75 CTEGPA
  - Earn a 2.0 CGPA (9-12)
  - If ProStart certified: possible 10 college credits
  - Submit proper paper work
  
- **Tech prep @ Hocking College= 3-6 college credits**
  - Submit proper paper work
  
- **ProStart Credits @ various schools= college credits/school**
  - Earn the ProStart certificate
  - Possible Credits at Hocking College, Midwest Culinary Institute, Ohio State University, Sullivan University, Owens Community College and more hours at Cuyahoga Community College
  - Criteria may differ per institution

**NOTE:** The granting of college credits is time sensitive. For optimal results, complete all necessary paper work before graduation
