When can I go?

- Monday - Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
 - * Closed for lunch between 12 noon and 1:00 p.m.

What do I need?

- Must be at least 18 years of age or older
- State issued photo ID
- Copy of your birth certificate (required at time of 1st training class)
- Proof of education - required at time of 1st training class (High school diploma or GED)

What do I do?

- Complete application
- Receive list of signatory contractors who may hire apprentices
- Receive a sample "Intent to Hire" letter
 - *Contractor signs "Intent to Hire" letter
- Take signed letter to Richfield Campus
 - *Complete paperwork and complete a drug test

To be accepted into the Apprenticeship Program
You **must** pass a **DRUG TEST**

Carpenters Local #373 and #435

What they do

Carpenters work with wood, metal, drywall and other building materials. They build stud walls and partitions for commercial buildings, hospitals, schools and stadiums.

Carpenters install interior doors, door frames, drywall, ceilings, cabinets and other interior fixtures.

Carpenters also build forms where concrete is placed for bridges, foundations and floors in multi-story structures.

What they earn

1st year apprentice starts at \$19.58/hour taxable, \$27.54/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity). Benefits start after 90 days.

Apprentices receive scheduled wage rate percentage increases.

Journeyman earns \$32.64/hour taxable, \$52.30/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).

Length of Apprenticeship

The Carpenters have a 4-year Apprenticeship Program
