## Where do I go?

## When can I go?

- Monday - Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

## What do I need?

- Must be at least 18 years of age or older
- Valid Driver’s license
- Proof of education (High school diploma or GED)

## What do I do?

- Complete application (downloaded from the website)
- Submit completed application and \$25 money order payable to “Cement Masons Local #404 JATC” by mail or in person at:

- All applicants will receive written notification of the date, time and location of testing

# Cement Masons' Local 404

## What they do

Cement masons work with cement, concrete and forming materials (wood, plastics, fiberglass). They form, place, sculpt, shape color, texture, stamp, smooth and finish wet concrete.

Cement Masons work on bridges, roadways, commercial buildings, hospitals, schools and stadiums.

Cement Masons may also install the forms to hold the wet concrete in place while it is curing (drying).

## What they earn

1st year apprentice starts at \$18.29/hour taxable, \$36.30/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).

Apprentices receive a wage rate percentage increase each year.

Journeyman earns \$31.50/hour taxable, \$52.05/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).
