- Tuesdays between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

## What do I need?

- Must be at least 18 years of age or older
- State issued photo ID
- Proof of education (High school diploma, GED or certified transcripts showing graduation date [sealed])

## What do I do?

- Complete general application
- Meet with representative from the Union and/or Training Center to review apprenticeship selection process
- Receive list of contractors who may hire apprentices
- Receive instructions on the next steps and how to proceed

# Glaziers' Local 181

## What they do

Glaziers work with ferrous metal (iron, steel), non-ferrous metal (aluminum), glass and alternative materials (plastic, fiberglass).

Glaziers fabricate and install various architectural metal and glass systems on the exterior and interior of buildings.

Glaziers work on commercial buildings, hospitals, schools, shopping centers and stadiums.

## What they earn

1st year apprentice starts at \$12.83/hour taxable, \$21.34/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).

Apprentices receive a wage rate percentage increase twice each year.

Journeyman earns \$32.07/hour taxable, \$49.99/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).

# Painters' Local 707

## What they do

Painters work with paint, wallpaper, wallcovering and other decorative materials.

Painters work on bridges, roadways, commercial buildings, hospitals, schools and stadiums.

## What they earn

1st year apprentice starts at \$12.76/hour taxable, \$21.97/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).

Apprentices receive a wage rate percentage increase twice each year.

Journeyman earns \$28.36/hour taxable, \$45.21/hour total wage package (this includes health insurance, pension and annuity).
