Wingate University's nationally accredited MBA evening program has been serving Charlotte area professionals since 1991. Conveniently located in the heart of south Charlotte in the Ballantyne Corporate Park, our MBA program is offered throughout the year during weekday evenings and combines superior academic quality with affordable tuition. *Our MBA courses are offered via live online, in-person, and hybrid delivery based on student preference (ie. students may elect to take classes in-person at our Ballantyne Campus, live online, or a combination of both in-person and live online at their discretion).*

MBA Curriculum

The MBA curriculum consists of 36 credits which includes 12 three-credit courses. It is divided into two components: core courses (30 credits) and concentration courses (6 credits). Core courses cover the complete range of business disciplines and serve as the general management foundation for the program. Concentration courses provide added depth and relevance in specific areas of emphasis that connect to student career goals and professional interests. The five areas of concentration include: Project Management, Data Analytics, Health Care Management, Corporate Innovation, and General Management.

Prerequisite Course for Non-Business Majors – Business 500

Wingate offers a unique one semester prerequisite course (Business 500) for non-business majors or for those who require some or all of the business prerequisites. This fast track prep course satisfies all of the prerequisites for the MBA program in only one semester and facilitates rapid entry into the program. Although Business 500 is only offered in the fall, it is possible for students to begin the MBA Program in the preceding spring or summer by taking certain MBA courses that are not prerequisite-based. These students then take the applicable modules of Business 500 in the following fall.

Course Sequence

Classes meet on weekday evenings with the ability to commence your studies during any semester (fall, spring, and summer). Take advantage of the program's on-going flexibility to sequence courses around your schedule so you can complete the program in only two to three years based on your professional goals.

Tuition*

\$4,110 Business 500 Prerequisite Course (\$1027.50 per module as applicable; offered during fall semester)

\$685 per MBA credit hour

\$2,055 per MBA course

\$24,660 total program cost with no BUS 500 (12 courses x \$2,055 per MBA course; BUS 500 courses are extra)

\$28,770 total program cost including all of BUS 500 (\$24,660 for MBA courses + \$4,110 for all of BUS 500)

**Effective for 2022-2023 academic year. Other than textbooks, there are no additional fees for the program.*

For students who receive assistance through their company's tuition reimbursement program, tuition payments are deferred until the end of each semester, which can save out-of-pocket expenses.
