## LMP Dress Code

---

Students are required to follow the dress code. Our main objective is to create a positive learning environment and standardized expectations for student apparel. The following guidelines indicate appropriate dress.

### **General Guidelines:**

- Students must be in LMP school uniform while on campus.
- Uniform Top: LMP polo in burgundy, white, or gray (black is for Seniors only).
- Uniform Bottom: Plaid, khaki or black skorts, shorts, or pants may be purchased from any uniform vendor. Cargo pants and denim are not allowed. Leggings and athletic shorts/sweatpants are not a substitute for uniform bottoms.
- LMP sweaters and sweatshirts are the only outerwear garments that can be worn in the building. A LMP polo must be worn under outerwear. Non-LMP outerwear garments may be worn outside, but not inside the building.
- Lower School students are highly encouraged to come to school in their LMP PE uniform on assigned PE days. PE uniforms can be worn the entire day.
- LMP athletic clothes (LMP spirit shirt and black/gray athletic shorts or sweatpants) are to be worn during PE class only for all Middle and Upper School students.
- Athletic team uniforms and other club or activity apparel may be worn according to school guidelines.
- Open-toed, open-backed shoes, and sling back shoes are not permitted in school. All students must wear athletic and/or closed-toed shoes only. Boots, sandals, slip-ons, slides, wheelies, etc. are not allowed.
- Clothing must be clean, well maintained, modest and of appropriate size. All clothing should fit without being too tight, baggy, or revealing.
- Prohibited clothing or styles include the following: off-the-shoulder tops, hats, bandanas, visible under garments, offensive (i.e. drug, alcohol or sexual references/innuendos), torn or cut clothing, visible body or facial piercing (lip, nose, eyebrows, tongue, etc.), or visible tattoos.
- Unnatural color or distracting hair styles (to include logos, distracting designs and mohawk styles) are not allowed. Hair must be well-groomed and proper hygiene is expected of all LMP students.
- Students may wear earrings (no hoops larger than 1" in diameter). Wide gauges are not allowed.
- Jewelry (necklaces and/or bracelets) may be worn if it is small in size and does not exhibit any offensive symbols.
- Sunglasses are not authorized for wear in the building.
- Makeup is not permitted for Lower School students.

**Girls (Lower School):**

- LMP Jumper in plaid, black, or khaki
- LMP Jersey Dress
- LMP Headband or LMP Bow
- Leggings may be worn under skorts or dresses. Leggings are not a substitute for uniform bottoms. Leggings must be in solid school colors (burgundy, black, white, or grey).

**Casual Dress Days/Dress Down Days:**

- LMP Spirit Fridays: Any spirit shirt may be worn with jeans or regular uniform bottoms ONLY. Jeans may not have any holes, rips or cuts.
- Special Dress Down Days will be announced throughout the year. (Example: Winter Week, Pajama Day, Senior Week, etc.)
- Monthly \$2 Dress Down Days will be announced benefitting local charities. Students may wear any school appropriate clothing with athletic shoes.

**Campus Store:**
