Committee Reports:

Risk Management – Veronica – There were two injury reported in March. One was at Baldwin caused by uneven asphalt. The area has been fixed. The other incident did not require any follow up.

Student Safety – Marailee did not have anything to report

Site Liaison – Val Wood reported for teachers

Sp Ed teachers requested adult size shields. They currently have student size. Van stated they distributed what they had in stock. Everyone is currently out of stock of shields.

Paras would like shields when available.

Val asked what the direction is for social distancing with teacher to student. Marailee stated there was no clear direction. Teachers and paras should wear proper PPE and address physical needs. Masks must be worn at all times. Val asked if classrooms could get purifiers. Oscar stated that would be a negotiated item. Oak Grove has fulfilled all of CDCs requirements.

Frank stated point of service was his only concern and it has been answered. All is good.

ARCC – Oscar and Ruth

Ruth stated there was a PPE form on the website for employees to fill out if they need masks, gloves, sanitizers, gowns, shields, etc.

N95 masks are supposed to be fitted. Who will be responsible? Non vaccinated employees must wear a N95 mask. Frank pulled a box of masks in the warehouse and the box stated the N95s are supposed to be fitted. Colleen stated there was a code out that stated under emergency situations the requirement for fitting can be overlooked. Colleen will send the code to Marailee. Remember, that emergency only applies for COVID exposure. M&O and anyone else that wears a N95 mask for their job function must be fitted.

The summer newsletter was discussed. Everyone should come back with edits and approval in May.
