Freshmen Course Selection

- Students will select 7 courses
 - English, Math, Science, Social Studies & Physical Education (5 classes)
 - 2 additional courses
 - Art, Business, Family & Consumer Sciences, Music, Technology,
 World Language
 - Excel/ Study Skills/Learning Strategies/Academic Reading/Math Reinforcement- credit bearing courses
 - Study Hall/Resource- non-credit courses
 - Some electives are full-year and some are semester in length.
 - Come to your appointment with at least 2 alternate elective courses
 - Course selections are finalized at the counselor meeting

Most common questions....

- Graduation requirements vs. college admission requirements
 - World Language
- 2.0 credits Elective Arts graduation requirement
 - 1.0 max from an elective arts departments
- PE requirement/PE exemption
- Study hall
- Balance
 - Honors vs non-honors
- What if I change my mind after my appointment....
 - Deadline to make changes is Feb. 4
 - Change of mind requests after schedules released on a space available basis only




