MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS



Applicants wishing to be considered for a Music Scholarship are expected to be of a standard equivalent to the following Grades on their principal instrument:

- > 10+/11+ at least Grade 3
- > 13+ at least Grade 5
- > 14+ at least Grade 6/7
- > 16+ at least Grade 8

The ability to play a second instrument is desirable, though not essential.

How to apply

- > Complete this application form and upload it as part of the main application. You will be prompted when to do this on the main application form
- > Submit a video recording of two contrasting pieces for preliminary assessment. Both pieces should be about 2-3 minutes long in which the applicants can showcase their abilities. Where applicants are offering two instruments, one piece for each instrument is required. Recordings should be emailed to Mrs Caroline Parsons, Music Administrator at crp@whitgift.co.uk with the Subject heading – 'Applicant full name, Entry Point (e.g. 10+, 11+) and Music Scholarship Recording', by the relevant application closing date
- > Certificates and testimonials are **not** required

Application Deadlines:

- > 10+/11+ Friday 11 November 2022
- > 13+/14+/16+ Friday 7 October 2022

Please note the scholarship form and video recording must be received along with the main application form by the relevant closing date to be considered. Both the scholarship application form and video recording must be submitted to be considered.
