Monthly Winners

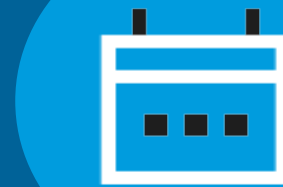
500 winners monthly January through March; 100 winners monthly April through October.


