How to Apply

Scholarship Information:

Students - Support Through Academic Resources and Services (S-STARS) is a scholarship program which will recruit and enroll eligible STEM students to participate in the project that pairs financial support with key evidence-based strategies for ensuring student success, retention, and program completion.

The project will provide 104 scholarships: 82 awards of up to \$5,500 to eligible students in STEM associate degree programs and 22 awards of up to \$6,800 to students in the final two years of a baccalaureate program. Strategic elements of student support are 1) intensive advising, 2) cohort engagement, including use of digital tools/social media to deliver information and services, 3) faculty mentor relationships, and 4) career exposure.

Eligibility Criteria:

- *Minimum 3.0 GPA*
- *Full-time enrollment each semester (12+ credit hours)*
- *Ability to attend required meetings and workshops throughout semester*
- *Current FAFSA on file with the Financial Aid department and Pell-eligible*
- *Declared major in one of the following STEM programs:*
