The solution is simple – **we bring the clinic and glasses to the children.**

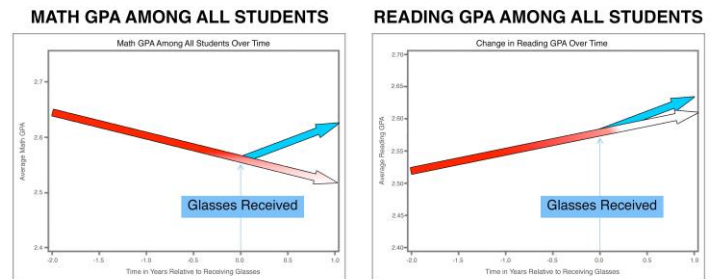


- 95% of 1st graders who need glasses do not have them
- Most undetected/undiagnosed vision issues can become permanent if not treated before age 6
- 80% of all learning during a child's first 12 years is obtained through vision, and those unable to read well by the end of 3rd grade are more likely to drop out of school
- Low-income and minority students are disproportionately affected with vision issues

The Need

The Research

A study conducted by The Mattel's Children Hospital at UCLA confirms that children who received glasses from Vision To Learn improved their math and reading scores within one year.



The Clinic

- Vision To Learn mobile clinics are in schools and at youth service programs everyday seeing over 25 kids at each location, each day
- Because we bring the clinic to schools and organizations, the amount of time missed in the classroom is significantly reduced
- We not only provide glasses, but our exams detect other serious health and eye problems such as amblyopia, glaucoma or motor skills deficiencies caused by vision impairments
