

YOU'RE NEVER TOO OLD TO KEEP LEARNING

“It is true that as we get older, some of our learning abilities do change”, says Tracy Lippard, MD, a geriatrician at Kaiser Permanente in Colorado. “We tend to be a little slower at recalling and remembering names and have more difficulty with multi-tasking or shifting our attention. On the positive side, however, we have learned a lot from a lifetime of accumulated knowledge and experiences and can apply this to new learning.” “The well-known adage that you can’t teach an old dog new tricks is false,” adds Tracey Gendron, PhD, executive director of the Virginia Center on Aging at Virginia Commonwealth University and chair of the Department of Gerontology at VCU College of Health Professions. “Research has demonstrated lifelong brain plasticity and the ability to learn new things and improve skills and abilities.”

While older adults may need more time to complete a task or challenge, they can often cognitively perform just as well as younger individuals, according to Jamie Sharp, MD, chief medical officer for Aetna Medicare, a CVS Health company. “What’s more,” she says, “growing evidence suggests that our brains can change and adapt, allowing individuals to adjust and learn new skills, even at an older age.” “I am a firm believer that, if anyone wants to learn, they can learn, no matter their age,” adds Rachel Ramirez, MPSA, executive director for the Lifelong Learning Institute in Chesterfield, an organization supported by VCU’s Virginia Center on Aging in partnership with Chesterfield County, Virginia. “The definition of lifelong learning is ‘The use of formal and informal learning opportunities throughout life for personal fulfillment.’ There is no age requirement or limitation to lifelong learning.”

There are many benefits of lifelong learning. Research bears out these sentiments. Continuing to learn even (or especially) into our later years, has many benefits, including:

Professional and Personal Development. If you’re not ready to retire or transition into another career (or even a volunteer position), adding to your skillsets can be worthwhile.

Community and Society Improvement: More than 15 million people in the United States and Canada say they take an informal or formal lifelong learning class every year, which not only benefits themselves but also society as a whole. Research shows that those who pursue lifelong learning opportunities are approximately 20% more likely to support community organizations such as recreation departments, public schools and higher education.

Better Mental and Physical Health: By continuing to use our brain we are improving our cognitive functioning. Research has found significantly fewer memory issues in older learning adults and that older adults who participated in a mentally stimulating pastime (learning an instrument or a new language), demonstrated a long-term increase in their memory skills. From a physical standpoint, lifelong learning has also found to lower the incidence of depression and anxiety, and reduce the rate of physical health conditions such as diabetes, stroke, emphysema, cardiovascular disease, ulcers, and more.

Increased Socialization: “One of the consequences of living in an inherently ageist society is the marginalization and exclusion of older people from opportunities for growth, learning, learning and meaning-making” says VCU’s Tracey Gendron. “This lack of participation can lead to social isolation and poor mental health.” Taking classes, however, can promote feelings of community and camaraderie and can offer an opportunity to form new friendships. (Thanks to Spotlight on Senior Living.) So here we’ve heard from the experts, and next week you’ll read about the various learning opportunities you might look into if you’re interested in pursuing some form of education in the days ahead.

LOOKING FOR RESPITE CARE?

Adult day care centers can be lifesavers for caregivers of those suffering from dementia and other cognitive conditions. Patients look forward to going and are well cared for while there. But one must do their homework and know what to explore further before choosing a place for their loved one. Experts suggest focusing in these areas to learn as much as you can about an adult day center.

First of all, there are the Basics: Are there a minimum number of days per week that participants must attend, and is transportation to and from home provided? Most centers offer it. What about locked sections so that someone can’t wander off? Check out the security. Then there’s Staff. Compare the center’s staff-to-client ratio with the industry standard of six participants to one staff member, not including administrators. Ask about staff training and turnover. Lastly, there are Activities. Check out the calendar of activities and look for both physical and cognitive stimulation – for example, crafts, chair exercises, and music and dance therapy, even aroma therapy. Lots to think about before making that final decision.
