X. SCHOOL STUDENT SHOWCASE

Centerfield's Fourth Grade Teachers and select student leaders showcased the Personalized Learning Program for Math.

Teachers and students utilize Personalized Learning during our PRIDE Time (Intervention and Enrichment Block for Math). This unique program is a blended learning experience for students to practice and master specific skills that NWEA's MAP assessment identifies as needing to be developed for each individual student. Students follow a personalized plan to develop standards, interfacing with learning videos and online practice opportunities tied to the standards they need to develop, then sign up for an assessment when they are confident they can show mastery of the standard. Teachers monitor progress and provide specific feedback to students after an assessment. Sometimes, it's a quick high five celebration and other times it is a re-teach opportunity utilizing manipulatives.

As a result of Personalized Learning, students are taking ownership of their learning and working hard to master math standards, they are developing a growth mindset about mathematics (which we know will bode well for their futures) and they are growing at an incredible rate! We can't wait for you to meet our 4th grade Personalized Learning Ambassadors and their amazing teachers!

XI. RECOGNITIONS

Kentucky observes School Board Recognition Month in January, and Oldham County Schools is proud to celebrate our dedicated board members. Joyce Fletcher, Kevin Woosley, Larry Dodson, and Patrick Kehoe spend countless hours serving the students, families, and community members of Oldham County. They bring a collective 48 years of school board experience to our district.

Oldham County Schools is proud to announce that 16 teachers obtained their National Board Certification in December.

National Board Certification recognizes accomplished teachers who work to generate continued improvement in the learning environment. This certification is a voluntary, advanced teacher credential which can take several years to complete. It is a rigorous, peer-reviewed process that ensures teachers have proven skills to advance student achievement. As part of this process, teachers must analyze their teaching context and students' needs, demonstrate what they have done outside of the classroom to improve student success, submit videos of their teaching, and provide student work samples that demonstrate growth. Additionally, candidates must submit essays describing, analyzing and reflecting on their practices and the evidence, and pass an exam to demonstrate they have mastered their chosen content area of certification. Just under 3% of the nation's teachers are nationally board certified.
