

**OLDHAM COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION**  
**MEETING MINUTES - *Amended***  
**May 18, 2021**

**SPECIAL CALLED BOARD MEETING**

The Oldham County Board of Education met in a special called session at the Arvin Education Center in La Grange, KY, on Monday, May 18, 2021, with the following members present: Joyce Fletcher, Board Chairperson; Kevin Woosley, Board Vice Chair, (*attended virtually*), Larry Dodson, Board Member; Patrick Kehoe, Board Member; Suzanne Hundley, Board Member and Anne Coorsen, General Counsel to the Board.

**I. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**

Chairperson Fletcher called the meeting of the Oldham County Board of Education to order at 6 p.m.

**II. AGENDA APPROVAL**

With no changes to the agenda, chairperson Fletcher, called for a motion and a second to approve. On a motion by Suzanne Hundley, seconded by Larry Dodson, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the May 18, 2021, special called board meeting agenda. (5-0).

**III. EXECUTIVE SESSION**

Chairperson Fletcher stated that the Board would need to go into executive session to pursuant to KRS 61.810(1)(f) to discuss the appointment or dismissal of an employee.

Chairperson Fletcher then called for motions of the Board to go into executive session. On a motion by Patrick Kehoe, seconded by Suzanne Hundley, and unanimously carried, the Board went into executive session pursuant to KRS 61.810(1)(f) at 6:01 p.m. (5-0).

The Board returned from executive session at 7:15 p.m. coming out of Executive Session, the following action was taken coming out of executive session.

*“The Board has just returned from Executive Session during which the Board discussed selection of the next superintendent. Prior to taking any action, I would like to thank my fellow board members and members of the Superintendent Screening Committee for all their work getting us to this point. I would also like to thank Mac MacWilliams and Andy Moore for hosting the candidate forum on May 6<sup>th</sup>, which despite the pandemic was very successful.*

*Selecting a new superintendent is one of the most important, and most difficult decisions that a board like ours makes. We have to consider the needs of the district right now, as well as 3 or 4 years in the future, and try to find the candidate with the experience and abilities that will best meet those needs. It is a lengthy evaluation process for both the candidates and the board, but we are committed to taking the steps necessary to hire the right candidate.*

*I move that the Oldham County Board of Education extend an offer of employment as superintendent of the Oldham County Schools, on the terms and conditions to be agreed upon prior to the June 28, 2021 regularly scheduled board meeting, to Dr. Jason Radford.”*

On a motion by Patrick Kehoe, seconded by Suzanne Hundley, and unanimously carried, the Board agreed to extend an offer of employment as superintendent of the Oldham County Schools to Dr. Jason Radford.

**IV. ADJOURN**

With no further business to discuss, Chairperson Fletcher, called for a motion and a second to adjourn. On a motion by Suzanne Hundley, seconded by Patrick Kehoe, and unanimously carried, the Board adjourned the May 18, 2021, meeting at 7:17p.m. (5-0).
