

**OLDHAM COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION  
MEETING MINUTES  
May 23, 2022**

The Oldham County Board of Education met in regular session at the Arvin Center, on Monday, May 23, 2022, with the following members present: Joyce Fletcher, Board Chairperson; Larry Dodson, Board Member; Suzanne Hundley, Board Member; Andrea Neikirk, Board Member; and Jason Radford, Superintendent and Secretary to the Board.

Patrick Kehoe, Board Member, was absent from the meeting.

The meeting was held in person, live streamed and recorded.

**1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**

Chairperson Fletcher called the meeting of the Oldham County Board of Education to order at 4:30 p.m.
