

**OLDHAM COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION  
MEETING MINUTES  
SEPTEMBER 30, 2021**

**TAX HEARING**

The Oldham County Board of Education met in Special Called session at the Arvin Education Center in La Grange, KY, on Thursday, September 30, 2021, with the following members present: Joyce Fletcher, Board Chairperson; Larry Dodson, Board Member; Patrick Kehoe, Board Member; Suzanne Hundley, Board Member; Andrea Neikirk, Board Member, and Jason Radford, Superintendent and Secretary to the Board.

**1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**

Chairperson Fletcher called the meeting of the Oldham County Board of Education to order at 6:30 p.m.

**2. AGENDA APPROVAL**

With no changes to the agenda, chairperson Fletcher, called for a motion and a second to approve. On a motion by Patrick Kehoe, seconded by Andrea Neikirk, and unanimously carried, the Board approved the September 30, 2021, special called board meeting agenda. (5-0).

**3. SUPERINTENDENT REPORTS**

Finance Officer, Stephanie Anderson presented a report of Available Property Tax Rates for FY22 (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022). Question and Discussion from the board members followed the report. The Board took the report under advisement.

**4. MONTHLY PUBLIC EXPRESSION**

Chairperson Fletcher stated it was time for public expression and called upon the public expression registrar. The following people had registered to speak: Ms. Bethany Shoemaker and Mr. Blaine Anderson. Each speaker was given several minutes to address the board and in-depth discussion about the OCBE Budget took place.

**I. ACTION ITEM**

After Public Expression, the following action was taken.

**A. Approval of Property Tax Rates for FY22 (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022).**

Chairperson Fletcher called for a motion to adopt the Superintendent's recommendation for FY22 tax rates. On a motion by Suzanne Hundley, seconded by Larry Dodson, and unanimously carried, the board adopted the following FY22 tax rates: (5-0)


1. Adopt the tax rate of 80.0 cents per \$100 assessed value for both Real Property and Tangible Personal Property with the allocation of such tax rate being:

General Fund	57.6
Building Fund	22.4
2. Motor Vehicle Tax Rate of 64.3 cents per \$100 of assessed value
3. Utility Tax Rate of 3.0%

**II. ADJOURN**

Chairperson Fletcher, acting on the Superintendent's recommendation to adjourn, called for a motion and a second to adjourn. On a motion by Andrea Neikirk, seconded by Suzanne Hundley, and unanimously carried, the Board adjourned the September 30, 2021, meeting at 6:57 p.m. (5-0).
