### PRINCIPAL/ADMINISTRATOR RESPONSIBILITIES CODE OF ACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR AND DISCIPLINE

General Responsibilities; In addition to any duty outlined in the applicable job description, a Principal/Administrator has the responsibility to:

1. Become familiar with the student code of acceptable behavior and discipline;
2. Help create and maintain an atmosphere which respects the rights of all participants in the school process;
3. Administer disciplinary measures fairly and equally in accordance with this conduct code;
4. Exhibit exemplary behavior in terms of action, dress and speech
5. Communicate this code of acceptable behavior and discipline to the school community;
6. Fulfill the terms of job description; and,
7. Immediately report to a local law enforcement agency or the Kentucky State Police, the Commonwealth's or county attorney, the Cabinet for Health & Family Services or its designee, if he/she knows or has reasonable cause to believe a child is neglected or abused and further to advise the Pupil Personnel Department in a timely fashion, that such a report has been made.
