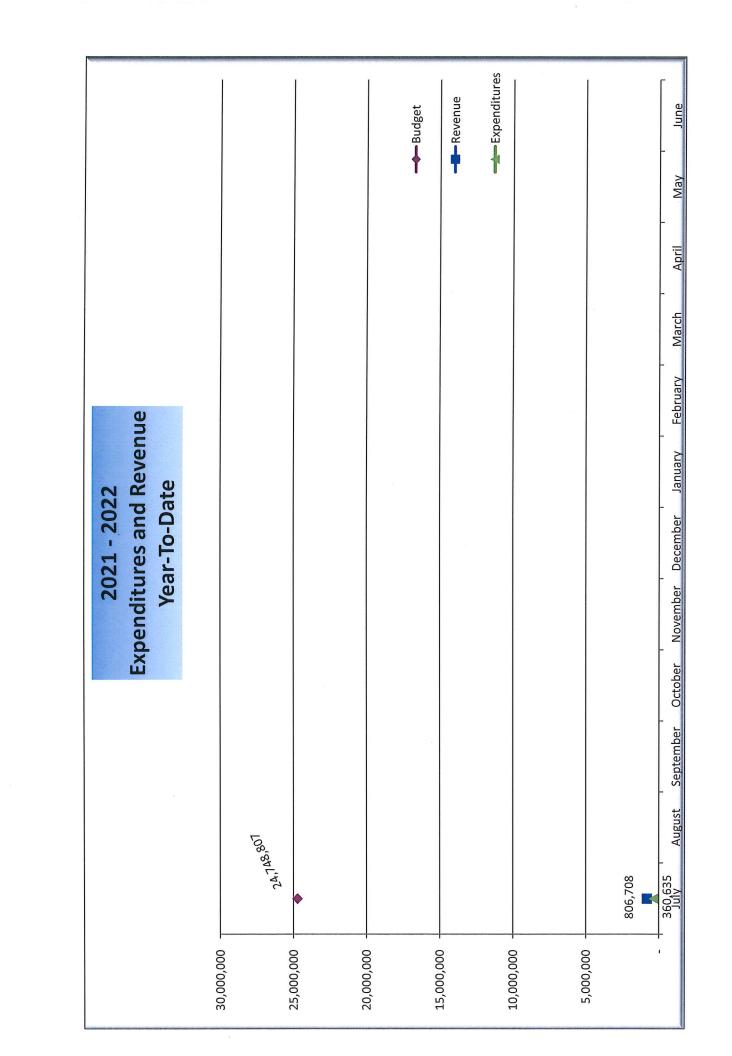

Subject: Motion to approve the Revised PCPS Calendar for the 2021-2022 school year

Background

The Poquoson City School Division participates in the development of the regional calendar through its representation on the Regional Calendar Committee. This affords PCPS substantive operational efficiencies and our students' schedules coincide with the schedules of the regional programs such as New Horizons, Governor School and Newport Academy. The school division calendar, which must be approved annually by the School Board, shall contain a minimum of 180 instructional days, contain a minimum of 140 hours for high school courses, 990 cumulative instructional hours, and comply with Virginia State Code.

Discussion

Following the completion of the work of the Regional Calendar Committee, and the approval of the original 2021-2022 division calendar on March 16, 2021, additional feedback from staff members indicated that the Wednesdays that students did not have live or synchronous classes in the 2020-2021 school year, due to COVID-19, was very valuable time for both collaborative planning for student needs and teacher professional development. Given this feedback, there was a need to give teachers more professional development and collaborative planning time within the constraints of the current calendar. In order to accomplish this within the constraints of the approved calendar, rescheduling some of the eleven (11) early dismissal days within the calendar was the best option available. VDOE requires that school divisions have at least 180 instructional days or 990 hours of instruction. The PCPS division calendar exceeds both of these requirements at 181 instructional days and 1,170 instructional hours or above for all schools. This calendar recommendation does not include any additional early dismissal days, just repurposing some of the existing days in order to align the calendar priorities with staff needs.
