Here are a few suggestions for annotating as you read your required book:

Underline key passages that you find interesting or important
Use sticky notes or marginal notes to mark observations, questions, and connections
Mark lines that help you understand the characters and plot

Additionally, you must select and highlight at least 3 quotations that are interesting or thought-provoking and be prepared to discuss these quotations in class. There will be a written assessment in September.
