

Our Transitional Program is located in the center of the Sayreville Community

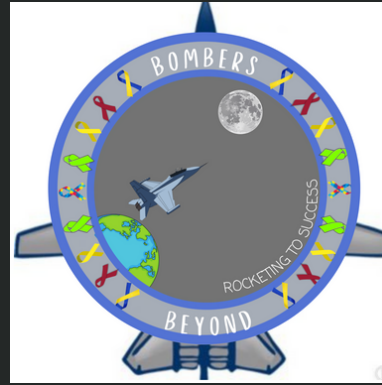
Our Adult Students....
