Students must obtain teacher recommendation and meet grade requirements in prerequisite courses to enroll in AP courses. Students may begin taking AP courses in 10th grade. Any student wishing to take **more than three AP courses a year must obtain special approval.** Students enrolled in an AP course must sit the exam.

GLOBAL SCHOLARS

The Global Education Program raises student awareness of the varied experiences of global communities through exploration of different and diverse cultures. **Students who successfully complete the two-year program receive the academic designation of Global Scholar.** Program requirements include participation in round table discussions, a Global Education research project, school-wide project awareness campaign development, and cultural exchanges in China, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Ireland, Italy, and Tanzania.

Fordham Preparatory School is committed to instilling in its students the understanding that what they have been given and learned is to be put in the service of all God's creation, especially those in need. Fordham has a **four-year service program for all students.** Students complete **17,000 service hours every year.**
