OSHKOSH AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT PROJECT PROGRESS REPORT

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

At Vel Phillips Middle School, the continued progress of the building structure is evident in the walls and steel rising on the West side of the building. In addition to the building rising, the curb and gutter work for the new parking lot is nearly complete, with the first layer of asphalt down to allow for temporary parking for contractors. Putting this first layer of asphalt down has worked successfully in past projects to be a temporary surface, and then the final coat of asphalt will be installed in the summer of 2023. Continued work at the stormwater detention ponds and relocation of utilities on the North side of the Vel Phillips site are still ongoing.

PLANNING & DESIGN UPDATE

At the Webster-Stanley site, design work continues to be in full swing. OASD and Bray Architects have made good progress with implementing the design intent on both the exterior and interior of the building. In late June, we held our second user group meeting, where OASD Administration and Bray Architects met with Webster Stanley ES, Merrill ES, and Washington ES staff to get feedback on the building design and layout to best accommodate their day-to-day needs.

At the Vel Phillips Middle School project, OASD partnered with Bray Architects to help with environmental graphics and branding to help bring the school to life. The design work on this is now complete, and over the next few months, you will see some of the graphics via renderings.
