



Proof of Residency Requirements Documents Required

In order to ensure that LVISD resources are being utilized for students who reside in LVISD, all students in the following categories will be required to provide proof of residency for the 2022-23 school year.

Verification of Residency Documents are Required from:

- Returning LVISD students
- Students New to La Vega ISD
- Students who previously attended La Vega ISD but did not attend in 2020-2021

Verification of Residency Documents are Required to be uploaded to Parent Portal during the Online Registration process. A student's registration will not be complete without the required Verification fo Residency documents listed below.

Under Texas Education Code §25.001(b)(1), a student is entitled to admission if the student and either parent reside in the district. This document provides information on the documents needed to help prove residency requirements. If you are unable to provide the requested documents, please discuss the matter with your child's school.

All applications for enrollment in LVISD public schools under TEC §25.001 will require at least two proofs of residency. If these documents supporting proof of residency are not submitted within 35 days of enrollment or change of address, LVISD shall conduct an investigation to determine eligibility of the student/family. In the event that LVISD determines documentation was falsified and the student was not a resident of LVISD, the student will be required to withdraw from LVISD. LVISD may pursue legal action against a parent for the amount the district has budgeted for each student as maintenance and operating expenses under TEC §25.001(h)(2) for the period the ineligible student was enrolled in a LVISD school.

Failure to produce the appropriate documents for admission and enrollment may result in an investigation by school officials to determine residency eligibility of the student. The investigation may include a home-visit by a school official or Attendance Officer. The residency procedures outlined in this document do not apply to homeless students.

All new applicants and returning students must submit at least one document from each of the following two columns:

Termination notices are also not accepted.</p> <p>If a family is sharing housing with an individual or family and does not pay rent under temporary residency, the family shall submit a document from this column in the name of the person who owns or leases the property.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid Texas driver’s license ~ address matches other documents • Valid Texas driver’s license ~ address does not match other documents • Valid Texas photo identification card <p>NOTE: If the document from Column A is a document with the name of the landlord or person you are living with a copy of their valid Texas driver’s license or Valid Texas photo ID is required.</p> <p>Any type of special circumstance such as missing documentation may be discussed with a school administrator and/or designee.</p>
