

# FHS Plan for 5 Day a Week in Person Learning

## Schedules:

- Return to Maroon/White schedule with an abbreviated daily schedule
- No scheduled lunch period: school day goes from 7:50am to 1:15pm
  - Period 1/2: 7:50-8:55
  - Period 3/4: 9:00-10:05
  - Advisory: 10:10-10:55
  - Period 6/7: 11:00-12:05
  - Period 8/9: 12:10-1:15
  - Staff Lunch: 1:15-1:45 (students take a bag lunch home or eat in the cafe)
  - Faculty Prep Time/Office Hours: 1:45-2:40
    - Optional study hall for any student and student-athletes: 1:45-2:30
      - Supervised by Ed Techs
    - Prep Time for Teachers
      - Afternoon Prep (1:45-2:40): 55 min x 5 = 275 min/week
      - PLC/Prep during the day - supervise or coverage when needed
        - Coverage for 30 min; 30 min prep (30 min x 3 = 90 min)
        - If no coverage needed, 65 min prep (65 x 5 = 325 min)
      - Total: 510 min/week if coverage needed, 600 min/week if not
        - Currently 375 min/week

## Physical Space:

- Classrooms: enough space for 3 feet between students and 6 feet between teacher/students
  - Every room was measured to determine capacity
  - Teachers have the option of:
    - Keeping all students in the classroom if they can maintain 3 ft
    - Moving to a larger classroom
    - Sending students to an “overflow” area and teaching synchronously (no teacher has chosen this option thus far)
  - Windows will be opened as much as possible
  - Air filter on
  - Doors open to increase ventilation
- Classes go outside when possible (set up outdoor classrooms again)
- Some seniors will leave at the start of May for Senior Projects, others at the end of May
- Passing Periods:
  - Students enter and exit the door closest to their classrooms
  - Continue with limits on number of students in the bathrooms
  - Guidance hallway is one way only during passing periods

## Arrival:

- Students from the bus goes to the Cafe or FPAC
- Other students outside until 7:40am, (can be in cafe or FPAC lobby if need be)
- Students go straight to class - no walking laps inside (walk outside)
- Hallway by guidance area one way during all passing periods (open during class time)
- Late arrival and early dismissal for all grades, reduces numbers in study halls (1/2 & 8/9 only)
  - Grade qualifications required for early dismissal/late arrival for all grades
- Open campus for juniors and seniors only (Grade qualifications remain)
- Study hall is moved to cafeteria, use Ipad to sign in
  - Allows for study hall room to be open for class use

## Dismissal:

- First bus run at 1:30 (gives students 15 minutes to get lunch food before bus arrives)
- Second run at 2:30 ("late bus" allows students to stay for extra help)
  - 1:50 - 2:30pm - optional study hall / homework help in the cafeteria

## Nutrition:

- No changes to the breakfast schedule and procedure.
- **Kitchen will be open from breakfast to after school bus departure time.**
  - Eating during study halls, guided study halls and advisory study hall
  - A la carte and fruit available all periods of the day
  - Food served at 1:15 pm dismissal, prior to the 1:30 pm bus departure
  - Breakfast and lunch items, along with a la carte snacks, will be available throughout the full serving time period
  - Supervised lunch available from 1:15-1:45
  - Any students who have not eaten and are taking the bus will go to the front of the line at 1:15 dismissal
  - Signs will be posted at exit doors to remind students to visit the cafeteria prior to leaving school grounds if they have not yet eaten
  - Students can have a snack during times when passing classes outside and/or when a teacher takes students outside for a snack or mask break
- Capacity of the cafeteria is 150 on 3/26/2021
  - 6 foot distance will be maintained at all times while students are eating

## Remote Students:

- Fully remote students in FHS classes will still need synchronous instruction
  - Working to move fully remote students into the same section so there are fewer synchronous classes
  - Hired two teachers to alleviate some synchronous teaching requirements
  - Offering to have remote students come in for some classes

## **Preparation for April 5:**

- Two full planning days before we start: (students work independently at home)
  - March 31st (early release, some planning time, some meeting time)
  - April 1st: full planning day
  - April 2nd: full planning day
  - April 5th: All students back 5 days

## **Region 10 Students:**

- AM and PM Region 10 schedule will still work (both will miss advisory)
- Region 10 remains at 2 days/ week
  - Students will have study halls on “off” days or come in late/go home if they have transportation (van transportation where possible)
  - Will still have transportation at 2:30 if afternoon Reg. 10 student

## **Advisory:**

- Continue with callbacks and cafeteria study hall for advisees
- Open track when weather permits
- Clubs can meet in person, larger clubs can meet in FPAC lobby
- Advisors can take students outside in the first 10 minutes or during advisory if no callbacks (mask and snack break)
