runny nose

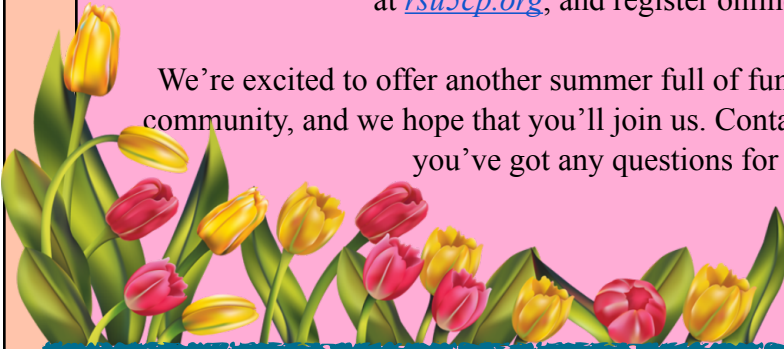

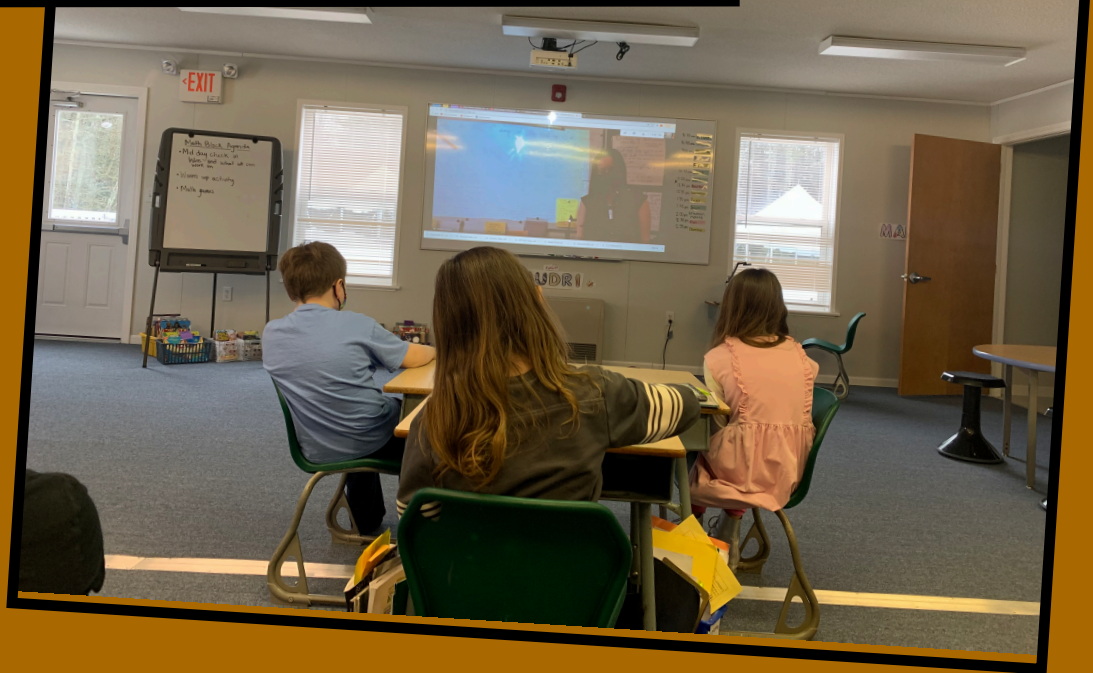


# THE CUBHOUSE

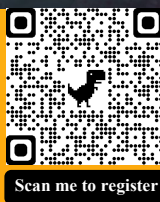
