KINDERGARTEN & PRE-KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION INFORMATION

We are currently enrolling kindergarten and pre-kindergarten students for the 2021-2022 school year. Children must be 5 years of age on or before October 15 to begin kindergarten and 4 years of age on or before October 15 to begin pre-kindergarten.

Most Common Symptoms of Covid 19:

Cough Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing Fever (100.4°F/ 38 °C or greater)* Chills Sore throat New loss of taste or smell

Less Common Symptoms:

Muscle pain Nausea or Vomiting Stomach pain Diarrhea Fatigue Headache Rash Swelling or redness of hands/feet Red eyes/eye drainage Congestion/ runny nose

*Fever is 100.4°F/ 38°C regardless of measurement location (oral, temporal).

It's such a BIG week for us at DCS! For the first time in nearly a year, we have ALL of our PK-5 students at school for in person learning!!


