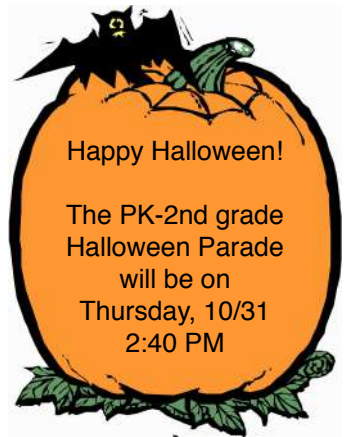


## It's Book Fair Time!!
