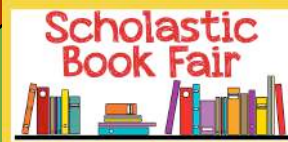

FLU CLINIC

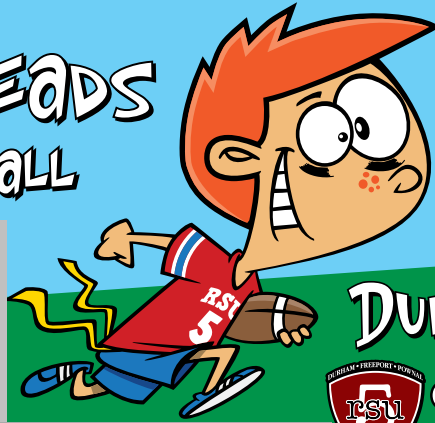
Please mark your calendars!
