## Important School Day Information

### PICKING UP YOUR CHILD AFTER SCHOOL?

If your child is not on the everyday pick up list and you want to pick him or her up at the end of the day (3:10) please call the office at 353-9333 **before 2:30** to put them on the list.

If a family member or neighbor will be picking up your child, please call the school to inform us, and ask that person to bring identification with them. We ask that you be patient with us while we get to know you.

### Visiting the School During School Hours?

The school is locked during the day. Reminder that if you are coming into the school during school hours you must stop in the office to sign in and receive a visitors pass.

### School Hours

Classes begin at 8:35 each day. It is very important that students are here on time and ready to begin with their classmates. Classrooms begin the day with a set routine and students arriving late often miss out on the "settling in" time that helps get the day off to a good start.
