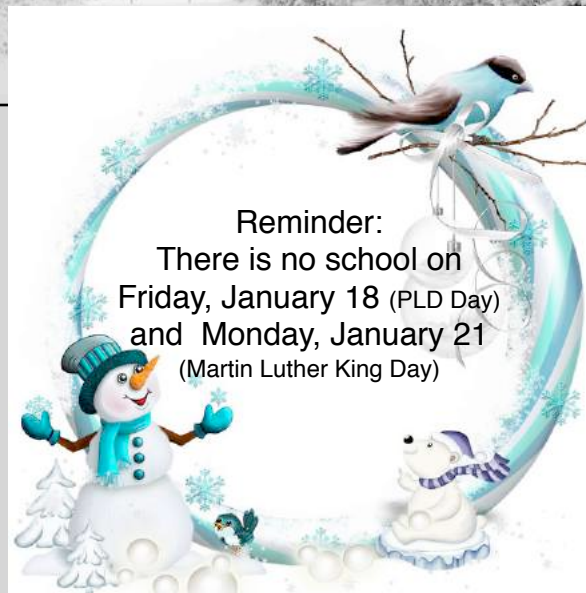

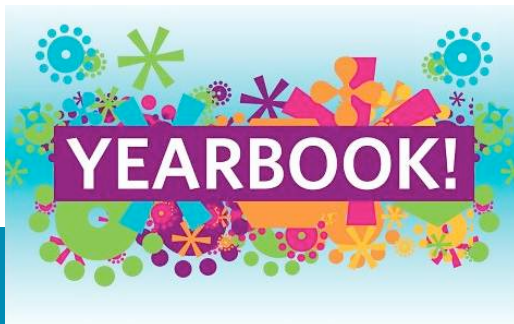


Got Baby Pictures?
