## 5TH GRADE FIELD WORK

On Monday the 5th grade took their science work out of the classroom and off to Popham Beach where they investigated both the constructive and destructive forces of moving water. In that setting our student scientists were able to make observations about erosion from the Morse River, collect sediment samples, and think about how this beach, like Earth's surface, is ever-changing. We witnessed how waves also help rebuild beaches and dunes.
