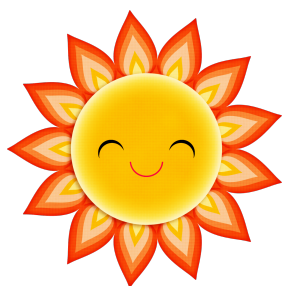
## Last Chance to Get A Copy

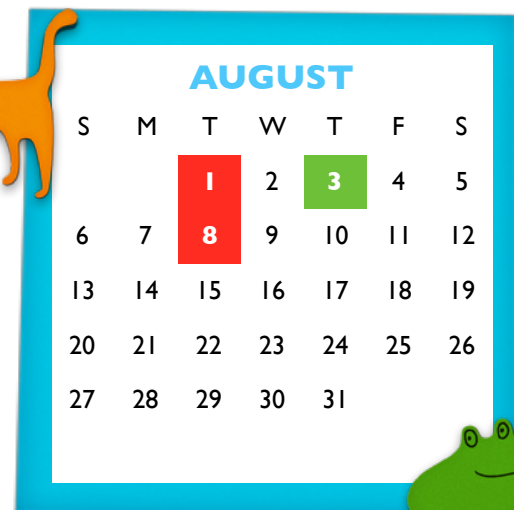
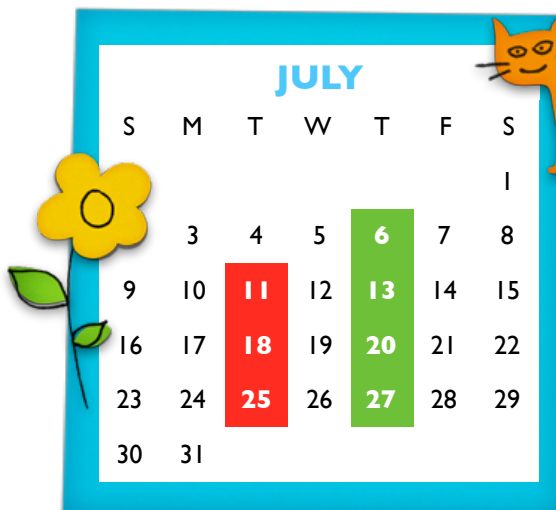
