On Wednesday, December 14th, the sixth grade students participated in a mind-bending puzzle called Breakout EDU. Breakout EDU creates ultra-engaging learning games for people of all ages. Games (Breakouts) teach teamwork, problem solving, critical thinking, and troubleshooting by presenting participants with challenges that ignite their natural drive to problem-solve.

Classes were split into two teams (a total of four teams in two classes) and split between Mrs. Hammond's room and Mrs. Daniel's room. The goal was for students to use the clues hidden in these classrooms to solve a series of challenges, riddles, and mysteries in order to "break out" in 50 minutes!

Out of the four teams, two broke out! One team did it with 27 seconds to spare!

This was an exciting math day, where students learned to push their thinking, problem solve, and work as a team. Can't wait for the next one!
