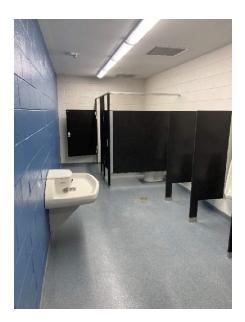

Status Flag Comment: Yellow status is due to material shipment delays that are occurring

- Building "D": OSF final Inspection passed on Thursday, February 24; Students and staff reoccupied the wing on Monday, February 28; The architectural punch list is 90% complete; MBK has provided BCSD with the material procurement log which details when remaining materials will arrive onsite, i.e. light drivers, cleanout covers, permanent sinks. After inspection and comments from the AHJ and OSF, MBK will pursue replacing the entire Fire Alarm System this Summer in lieu of phasing throughout the school year
- Building A: MBK began demolition on Tuesday, March 1<sup>st</sup>; Overhead work began on March 6<sup>th</sup>
- Building "H": Currently work is pending arrival of replacement parts for the kitchen equipment that needed to be repaired; MCT flooring is scheduled to arrive on March 9<sup>th</sup>; Furniture arrived on February 28<sup>th</sup>; OSF Final is scheduled for March 18<sup>th</sup>
- Building "G2" Addition: OH work is beginning in earnest; Roofers mobilized the week of March 6<sup>th</sup>. Material procurement log has been provided for this area; Ceilings are scheduled to be installed in May; OSF final is scheduled for June

## Battery Creek High School (Jumper Carter Sease Architects/M.B. Kahn Construction Co., Inc.)

- Locker Rooms: MBK is pending arrival of light fixtures and remaining plumbing fixtures to finalize locker rooms; Shipment dates continue to change on a weekly basis; MBK is looking into alternates to mitigate this ongoing issue
- Site Athletics: Slab pour occurred on March 4<sup>th</sup> at the concession building; Field house slab pour is scheduled to be placed on March 16<sup>th</sup>; Dugouts' slabs are in place and masonry is complete; Unmarked water line has been located under the future tennis courts; JCS is scheduled to issue an ASI the week of March 7<sup>th</sup>; Ward Edwards will then submit to BJWSA for their review and comments; Turf field subgrade is complete; Turf Field install began February 24<sup>th</sup>; MBK and JCS continue to look at alternative solutions for the Dominion Energy transformer that was reported to be a year out, current project needs call for the transformer to be installed by May; Dominion Energy anticipates being able to provide an update ASAP; Scoreboard is anticipated to ship in June
