Summer Reading Assignment for
Students Entering 5th Grade 2022 – 2023

1. Students entering **fifth grade** in September are required to read ONE of the books from the list below over the summer.

2. Students are then required to complete a **Digital Book Report** project. See project details attached.
 - *Gregor the Overlander* by Suzanne Collins
 - *Out of My Mind* by Sharon M. Draper
 - *The Red Pyramid* by Rick Riordan
 - *The Tale of Despereaux* by Kate DiCamillo
 - *Fort* by Cynthia DeFelice
 - *Absolutely Almost* by Lisa Graff

Overview of Project:

- Students will create a Google Slides presentation.
- The various slides will represent different elements of plot (setting, characters, summary of plot, etc.).
- The presentation may be **submitted via email** to your teacher any time after the first day of school (Thursday, September 1st).
 - Teacher will provide students with her email on the first day. They are also available on the school website. Further explanation and directions concerning submission will be given the first week of school.

Directions:

Every slide should contain a typed explanation and a minimum of one picture.

1. Create a presentation that represents the novel you chose.
2. Include the following categories in your presentation:
 - a. Title Slide (1 slide)
 - i. Include name of novel, author, and your name on slide.
 - ii. Include pictures.
 - b. Plot Slide (minimum of 3 slides)
 - i. Type summary of your novel in paragraph form. Include a paragraph for the beginning, middle, and end of your novel. Each part should have its own slide.
 - ii. Include pictures.
 - c. Setting Slide (1 slide)
 - i. Explain the setting of the story in sentence form.
 - ii. Include pictures.
 - d. Characters (minimum 1 slide)
 - i. Describe the major characters within the novel.
 - ii. Include pictures.
 - e. Conflict (minimum 1 slide)
 - i. List the major conflicts within the novel.
 - ii. Include pictures.
 - f. Solution (minimum 1 slide)
 - i. List the solutions to the conflicts within the novel. How did the characters solve their problems?
 - ii. Include pictures.
 - g. Opinion (minimum of 1 slide)
 - i. Explain in paragraph form whether you liked or disliked the book. Provide reasons why or why not. Use examples from the book to support your opinion.
 - ii. Include pictures.
