# Creating a School Community Through Expanded Opportunities and a New Campus

Over the next 10 years, more than 3,500 potential new K-12 students are expected to move into the district. Current projections show that 15 schools will be over capacity and we will have a deficit of nearly 2,500 K-12 seats for students by 2031 if we do nothing.

#### If Approved by Voters:

- Renovate existing Crestview Elementary building into the new South Washington Alternative High School
- Allows expansion of Park High School campus to work with the new South Washington Alternative High School campus
- Construction of Career and Technical Education (CTE) and Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) spaces
- Provides access to athletic fields and outdoor greenspace

#### If the Bond is Not Approved by Voters:

The current 10-year facility plan will be modified, but not dismantled, in order to address growth where it is occurring.
