



Consideration: None

Description: AP Biology is designed to be the equivalent of a college introductory biology course. Topics included in the course are biochemistry, cells and their processes, heredity, evolution, the structure and function of organisms, and ecology. Students will gain an appreciation of science as an ongoing process. They will work on understanding whole concepts, rather than memorizing only details. Laboratory work will be emphasized, with detailed write-ups included. Extra readings besides the text will be required with readings starting in August. This curriculum, developed by the AP Biology Committee, will prepare the student to perform at his or her best on the AP exam.

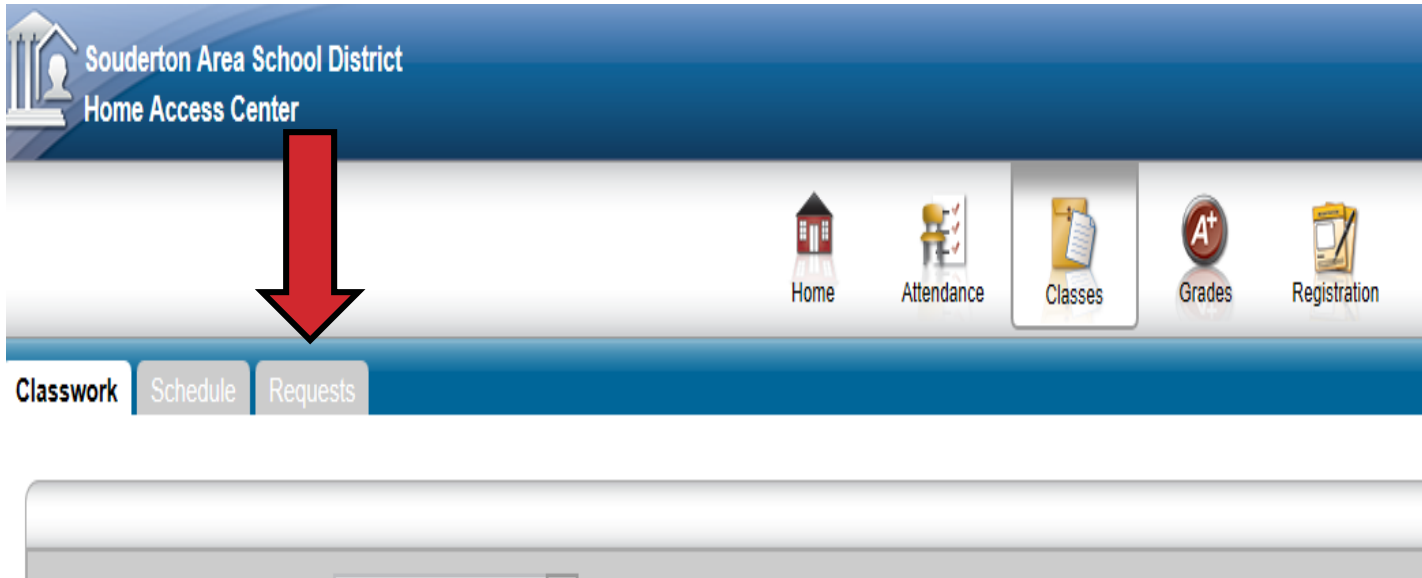





Total Credits

- Students in grades 9, 10 and 11 should select at least 7 credits. 8 is the maximum credit hours that can be completed in a school year. 7 credits would mean 1 block study hall. 7.5 credits would mean 1 quarter study hall
- Grade 12 students should request at least enough credits to meet graduation requirements (28 for a diploma, 29 Pathway or Scholar's diploma)
- Total credits should not include alternate course credits

You have completed the initial step in course selection. Each student will now meet with his/her counselor in December or February to review their course requests. Semester 1 social studies students will meet in December; Semester 2 will meet in February.

- There is no advantage/disadvantage to meeting earlier/later in the process.
- Students will receive their schedule in May.
- If a student wants to change a course request after meeting with their counselor and before receiving their schedule, please see/email your counselor.
- **Students will have until May 1 to change their course requests.**
- Once schedules are received, students will ONLY be able to change schedules once received if they did not receive a course request, have an imbalance in core courses, did not meet a prerequisite or would like to increase rigor.
- THERE WILL BE NO OPEN DROP/ADD PERIOD.
