

Starting a New Club at Souderton Area High School


A great way to get involved at Souderton Area High School is by joining one of our many clubs; however, if one does not exist that addresses your particular interests, do not hesitate to start a new one!

All clubs are subject to a multi-level approval process by Mr. Haines and Dr. Varano. To help ensure that your club meets the basic requirements, please read carefully and answer the following questions:

- 1. How will your club be different from any of the existing clubs we currently have at the high school? Each of our clubs should serve a unique purpose.
- 2. What is the goal of your proposed club? Why should Souderton Area High School support your club?
- 3. Do you have a teacher who will act as a moderator? All clubs at the high school require a teacher, guidance counselor, or administrator who is willing to act as the moderator and advisor of your club.

If you are different from any other club, have a goal that is related to the goals of the high school, and have a teacher moderator – you are ready to begin the application process!

Please read the following statement relating to members and moderators of all clubs at Souderton Area High School:

By signing and submitting this application for club status at Souderton Area High School, I am committing myself and my club, upon acceptance, to adherence to the following club policies:

- 1. All members of the Souderton Area High School student body who meet the requirements of club membership shall be admitted as a member.*
- 2. All members of this club are committed to the larger mission of Souderton Area High School: creating a positive and accepting atmosphere for all students, as well as working to encourage school spirit and participation in school activities through this club.
 - a. This club is committed to participating in Sophomore Orientation Night, Backto-School Night, Homecoming, and other school-wide events as active members of the Souderton Area High School Community.
- 3. This club understands there is limited funding for school clubs and all school clubs are seen as being self-supporting; therefore funding for this club must come from the members themselves, fundraising events, and/or sponsorship.
- 4. There is no stipend associated with the moderation of this club.

*The exception to this rule are those clubs which are unsanctioned P.I.A.A. team which may require cuts to be made based upon specific levels of skill in a particular area.
