The CLOC is an independent group of volunteers who will monitor all referendum building projects, schedules, budgets and expenditures. Quarterly reports from the CLOC are presented to the Beaufort County Board of Education and posted to this website. Minutes of CLOC meetings will also be posted once approved by the committee.

CLOC members bring a wide variety of professional experiences to their tasks. Members include CPAs, urban planners, civil engineers and project managers.

# **Bond Referendum Projects**

In 2019, Beaufort County voters' approval of the school district's \$344 million bond referendum – the largest bond referendum in the district's history – was a dramatic demonstration of support for our 22,000 students and the bright futures we aim for them to achieve.

Individual referendum projects, spread out over a four- to-five-year period ending in 2024 or 2025, can be found on the **<u>Citizen-Led Oversight Committee (CLOC) webpage.</u>** CLOC is an independent group of volunteers who monitor all referendum building projects, schedules, budgets and expenditures and provide quarterly reports to the Board of Education. 





A new addition to the campus was made possible by Beaufort County's bond referendum.




